## THE BELOVED COMMUNITY TEAM OF CHRIST CHURCH EPISCOPAL

The term “beloved community” is often attributed to The Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and it is akin to the biblical notion of the “Kingdom of God,” though its primary objective is to work at fostering God’s reign of equality and justice in the here and now. It is an interfaith endeavor.



In 2017 the Episcopal Church launched a long-term national campaign committed to “Becoming Beloved Community.” Christ Church’s BCT formed in response to that initiative.
